Cherry Blossom Festival, Shillong <u>A Rare Autumn Bloom in India</u>

Held every mid-November, the Shillong Cherry Blossom Festival celebrates the rare and stunning autumn bloom of Himalayan cherry blossoms. Unlike Japan's spring blossoms, these trees bloom in late autumn, painting the city in vibrant shades of pink.

The festival lasts 2 to 4 days and offers a perfect mix of nature, music, and cultural festivities. Key bloom spots include Ward's Lake, Shillong Golf Course, Pine Walk, and nearby Mawphlang village.

This one-of-a-kind celebration transforms Shillong into a floral wonderland, making it a must-visit during the season.

Nearest Airport

- Shillong Airport (Umroi Airport)- 30 km from Shillong city. (Limited flights, mostly from Kolkata)
- Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, Guwahati –120 km / 3–4 hours by road. (Major airport with flights from all over India)

Nearest Railway Stations

 Guwahati Railway Station (GHY) – 100 km / approx. 3 hours by road. (Well-connected to major cities across India)

Arrival in Guwahati – Transfer to Shillong

Arrive in Guwahati and transfer to Shillong (approx. 2 hrs). Check-in and relax amidst the hills. Overnight in Shillong.



Shillong – Cherry Blossom Festival Enjoy a full day at the vibrant Cherry Blossom Festival with pink blooms, live music, food stalls, and cultural events. Overnight in Shillong.





Shillong – Cherrapunjee Drive to scenic Cherrapunj

Drive to scenic Cherrapunjee, famous for waterfalls, caves, and dramatic landscapes. Overnight in Cherrapunjee.

Cherrapunjee – Dawki Excursion

Full-day trip to Shnongpdeng and Dawki—explore root bridges and enjoy boat rides on the crystal-clear river. Overnight in Cherrapunjee.

Altitude: 7,050 ft above sea level. Best Time to Visit: March–May (Spring bloom) and September–February (Post-monsoon, stunning views of snow-covered peaks). Climate: Cool and breezy year-round; temperatures in Pelling often dip below 10°C, especially from October onwards.

Location & Access

Pelling is nestled in the serene hills of West Sikkim, offering panoramic views of the majestic Kanchenjunga range. Known for its peaceful monasteries, sacred lakes, and natural beauty, Pelling is a harmonious blend of culture, spirituality, and Himalayan charm.

PELLING – Where Peace Meets the Peaks

Perched gracefully on the slopes of the Eastern Himalayas, Pelling is a tranquil town in West Sikkim that offers a soul-soothing blend of spiritual calm, natural grandeur, and cultural richness. From panoramic views of the Kanchenjunga range to sacred sites and historic ruins, Pelling is a place where every corner whispers a story of the past and every view awakens a sense of wonder.

The Spirit of Pelling

Suggested Route Itinerary

- Day 2: Pelling Local Sightseeing (Upper Pelling). (Pemayangtse Monastery, Rabdentse Ruins, Bird Sanctuary, Sangacholing Monastery, Helipad Viewpoint)
- Day 3: Pelling Local Sightseeing (Lower Pelling). (Khecheopalri Lake, Kanchenjunga Waterfalls, Rimbi Waterfall, Darap Village)
- Day 4: Excursion to Ravangla & Namchi. (Buddha Park, Chardham, Samdruptse Hill)
- Day 5: Leisure / Optional Excursions. (Singshore Bridge, Uttarey Valley, soft treks or mountain biking)
- Day 6: Day Trip to Yuksom. (Dubdi Monastery, Norbugang Park, Kathok Lake)
- Day 7: Departure. (Transfer to Bagdogra / Pakyong / NJP for onward journey)

Nearest Airport:

Pakyong Airport, Gangtok (Sikkim) Distance: ~117 km | Travel Time: Approx. 4 hours via NH 510.

Bagdogra Airport, West Bengal Distance: ~135 km | Travel Time: Approx. 5-6 hours by road.

Permit Requirements:

- Indian Citizens: No permit required
- Foreign Nationals: Inner Line

Permit (ILP) required obtainable at Rangpo or Melli check posts.
